The Atlantic Festival COVID-19 Policy

The Atlantic is committed to providing and maintaining a safe environment for our guests, speakers, underwriters, production partners, and employees.

Vaccination Policy

The Atlantic's COVID-19 vaccination policy limits access for in-person attendance at any company-organized event to individuals who have completed a full course of the COVID-19 vaccine. You will be considered fully vaccinated based upon the following criteria:

- You will initially be considered to have received a full course of vaccination two weeks after the date on which the final shot of your initial vaccine regimen is administered.
- Once eligible for a booster shot, you will have one (1) month from the date of eligibility to receive a booster shot. If you have not received a booster shot within that time frame, you will no longer be considered to have received a full course of vaccination until you receive a booster shot.

Mask Policy

Attendees are required to wear a mask at all times when indoors, except when eating, drinking, or presenting on stage.

On-Site Health Policy

The Atlantic requests that any attendees who are not feeling well or exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms not attend The Atlantic Festival in person. Additionally, if you have recently tested positive for COVID-19, you should not attend The Atlantic Festival in person unless you are no longer symptomatic, at least five calendar days have passed since the date of your first positive test, and you have tested negative subsequent to that five day period. And, of course, you should not attend The Atlantic Festival in person if you have otherwise been instructed to quarantine by a medical professional.

By attending The Atlantic Festival, you will abide by this policy in addition to all applicable local, state and federal COVID-19 mandates. *The Atlantic* may adopt additional reasonable COVID-19 rules and regulations in its sole discretion, including but not limited to testing requirements.

Please note that the event venues' staff at The Atlantic Festival are not subject to *The Atlantic*'s vaccination requirement. The venues will follow all local, state and federal government regulations at the time of the event. *The Atlantic* will update you of any material changes in the venue's policies and procedures, as we become aware of them.

The Atlantic reserves the right to change or adjust the COVID-19 policy requirements as the pandemic evolves or government requirements change and will make every effort to notify you in advance of any deadlines.
